Objectives and results

General Objective: Ensure respect for the right to land and promote the sustainable socio-economic development of rural communities including the most vulnerable groups in the central highlands of Angola.

Specific Objective: Strengthen the capacities of civil society and the State to effectively recognize, use, and manage the land of rural communities

R2: Titled rural communities improve land management and carry out productive initiatives

Result 1

Civil society and local administrations have greater knowledge of the Land Law and the Participatory Rural Delimitation (DRP)

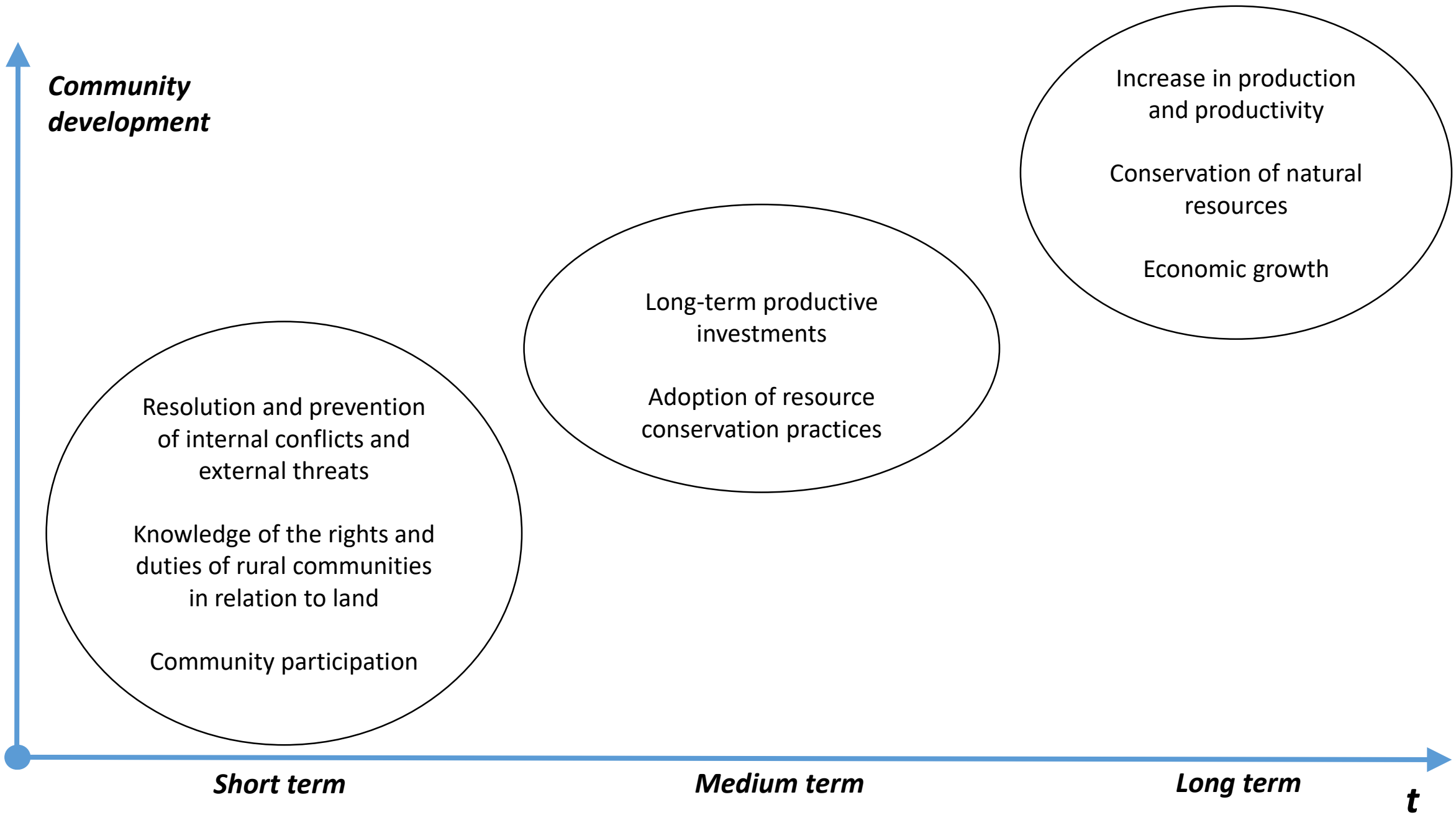
- Strengthen the capacities of 40 civil society technicians and 40 state technicians. In total, 80 technicians strengthened, 40 in each Province.
- The formations will be both theoretical and practical, implementing DRP in 40 rural communities



Result 2

Titled rural communities improve land management and carry out productive initiatives

- Provide assistance in the formulation of 10 Community Development Plans
- To support the community in the elaboration of 4 business plans involving vulnerable groups, and in the subsequent identification of sources of financing



Result 3

Extending the effective protection of customary land rights

- Organize events and debates to promote the active participation of civil society in the process of revision of the Land Law and its Regulation in Luanda and in the target provinces
- It will seek to elaborate proposals for the improvement of the legal and administrative framework regarding the recognition of customary rights

Results achieved so far

R1: Civil society and local administrations have greater knowledge of the Land Law and the Participatory Rural Delimitation (DRP)

R2: Titled rural communities improve land management and carry out productive initiatives

R3: Extending the effective protection of customary land rights

66 technicians from partner organizations and communities, **21** trained Local Administrations technicians; **43** communities with DRP completed, **7** titles issued

10 rural communities chosen with the support of the Local State Administration; **4** projects in formulation, to be financed
